Specialist NPQs

These qualifications allow deep exploration of a specific leadership domain and enable schools to build capacity in a targeted area.

- **NPQ in Leading Teaching (NPQLT)**

Our NPQLT is designed for ambitious teachers who lead or aspire to lead teaching in a subject, year group, key stage or phase.

- **NPQ in Leading Teacher Development (NPQLTD)**

Our NPQLTD is designed for any member of staff who has – or wants to have – responsibility for leading the development of other teachers in their school. This includes anyone interested in mentoring trainees or early-career teachers.

- **NPQ in Leading Literacy (NPQLL)**

Our NPQLL is designed for ambitious classroom teachers and middle leaders, who want to – or already – have responsibility for leading literacy across a school, year group, key stage or phase.

- **NPQ in Leading Behaviour and Culture (NPQLBC)**

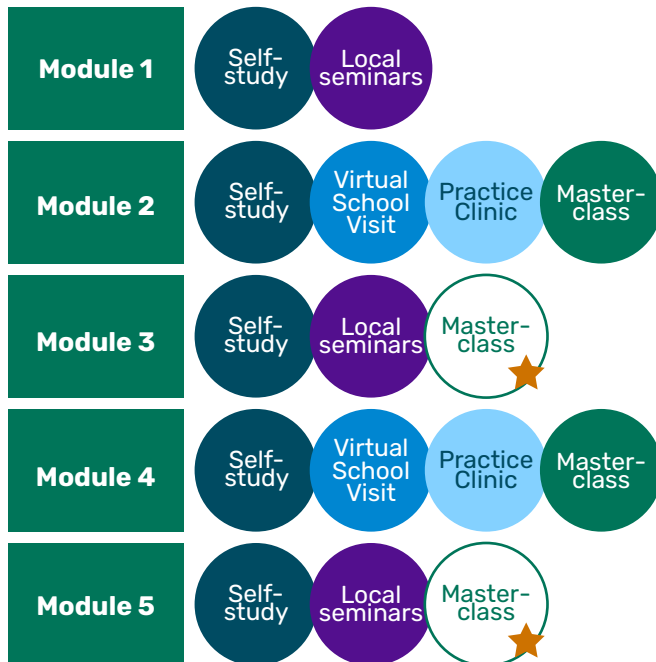

NPQs with NIoT@Tees Valley Teaching School Hub

- Programmes run across the Tees Valley region using experienced local school leaders as facilitators.
- Excellent personalised levels of support and communication from our central team.
- Half day face to face, or twilight online sessions, to accommodate teacher needs.



Features of the NIoT NPQs

- **Self-study** which draws together robust evidence with rich practice-led exemplification to build foundational knowledge and understanding of how to bring research to life. Designed as 2-hour units, between 4 and 8 hours per module, totalling 36 hours.
- Programme model which maximises the value of in-person **local seminars** to contextualise, build networks and plan for effective implementation with the opportunity scale and national presence provides to access renowned expertise. Delivered usually as 6-hour full days.
- High leverage live 1-hour **virtual visits** to schools, seeing exceptional practice in a 'real life' environment, with the 'invisible made visible' by narration from great leaders.
- Practice is a core feature of every programme, throughout local seminars and in 90-minute **practice clinics**, participants will build their understanding of the power of deliberate practice and their ability to use it to develop themselves and others.
- Online national 2-hour **masterclasses** hosted by nationally renowned experts from our network of specialist partners, including Associate Colleges.
